## CONSTRUCTION UPDATES:

With the construction project, the year ahead will be filled with changes and challenges. Together, we will navigate things to make sure that *everyone* is safe and informed.

### Entrances

The Main Entrance is now on the corner of Mary St. and William St. Please use the buzzer and we will welcome you into the building. Students will exit the building through the north doors near the library (On Colborne St.). Classes in the portables will enter and exit directly from the portable.

### **Student Drop-Off and Pick-Up—Grade 1 to 8**


During these times, students can come and go through two locations: 1) the stairs on Colborne St. Or 2) the gate on the corner of Colborne St. and Ontario St. With our reduced yard space, adults will be required to **remain on the sidewalk** during drop-off and pick-up times.

### **Student Drop-Off and Pick-Up—Kindergarten**

Our new kindergarten pen should be built next week. Until then, kindergarten pick-up and drop off will be at the Main Entrance. In the morning, you can drop your students off at the gym. In the afternoon, we will hand your child off to you at the main entrance. Once the pen is complete, we will transition to our normal outdoor routine.
